The Building Societies (Authorised Banks)
(No. 44) Order 1970

THE Chief Registrar of Friendly Societies, with the consent of the Treasury, pursuant to the powers conferred on him by Section 59(2) of the Building Societies Act 1962 and to all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order :

1. N. M. Rothschild & Sons Limited is hereby designated so as to be authorised to hold funds of building societies as mentioned in Section 59(1) of the Building Societies Act 1962.
2. The Building Societies (Authorised Banks) (No. 2) Order 1961 is hereby varied by the deletion in paragraph 1 of N. M. Rothschild & Sons.
3. This Order may be cited as the Building Societies (Authorised Banks) (No. 44) Order 1970.

REGULATIONS 1968
NORWAY: OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE

THE Secretary of State for Scotland gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food (Scotland) Regulations 1968 he hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule

to the Notice published in the *Edinburgh Gazette* dated 26th June 1970 for the importation of meat and meat products from Norway, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the *Edinburgh Gazette* dated 13th March 1970 is hereby revoked.

For casings only: to Certificates completed by the insertion of one of the following establishment numbers:—
202, 203, 204, 205.

For reindeer meat and reindeer meat products only: to Certificates completed by the insertion of one of the following establishment numbers:—
91, 92, 93.
