The Brandon Street (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1971

1. ON the 9th day of November 1971, the Town Council made the above-named Order under Section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

2. This Order will come into operation on the 29th day of November 1971 and will impose charges for the parking of vehicles of the specified class in the area shown in the Schedule attached hereto during the hours stated; these charges to be levied at the rate of 3p for two hours.

3. A copy of the Order and a map showing the areas affected are available at The Town House, Cadzow Street, Hamilton, where they may be examined between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

4. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the 9th day of November 1971, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

(Traffic Regulation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1971

1. ST. ANDREWS Town Council propose to make an Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

2. The effect of the Order will be:—

- (a) that vehicles must not be left at any time
 - (i) on either side of Union Street.
 - (ii) on either side of Westburn Lane.
- (b) that vehicles may not proceed along that part of Market Street between South Castle Street and Union Street otherwise than from east to west (instead of west to east as at present).
- (c) that motor vehicles may not proceed along (i) South Castle Street or (ii) Westburn Lane except for essential access.

3. Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the restricted lengths of road and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined in the Town Clerk's Office, 2 Queen's Gardens, St. Andrews from Monday to Friday during business hours.
