This Order, which makes it unlawful to drive a vehicle along Bain Square west from its junction with Morison Avenue to its junction with Perceval Road South in a southerly direction and along Bain Square east from its junction with Perceval Road South to its junction with Morison Avenue in a northerly direction except for a mechanical road cleansing vehicle when being used between the hours of 6 a.m. and 8 a.m., will come into operation on 3rd January 1972.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads affected are available at the Town Council Chambers, Stornoway, where they may be examined between 9 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from the 13th December 1971, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

BURGH OF STORNOWAY

The Burgh of Stornoway (Kenneth Street)

(Waiting Restrictions) Order 1971

ON 13th December 1971, the Provost, Magistrates and Councillors of the Burgh of Stornoway made the above-named Order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by subsections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967.

This Order, which makes it unlawful for any person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, to cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the west side of Kenneth Street between its junction with Francis Street and its junction with South Beach, will come into operation on 3rd January 1972. The prohibition does not apply in the case of vehicles waiting for certain purposes mentioned in the Order.

The Order revokes the provisions of the Burgh of Stornoway (Kenneth Street) (Waiting Restrictions) Order No. 2, 1966 in so far as they relate to the section of Kenneth Street between Francis Street and South Beach.
