WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

HOLLOW-WARE WAGES COUNCIL (GREAT BRITAIN)

THE Hollow-ware Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Secretary of State for Employment proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Hollow-ware) Order 1973 (Order H.(104)); (2) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Hollow-ware) (Holidays) Order 1971 (Order H.(102)); and (3) the revocation of Order H.(104) and Order H.(102).

Particulars of the proposals, which have been approved by the Pay Board, are contained in the Wages Council's Notice H.(105) which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below. The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals if made to it within 14 days from 19th February 1974.
