HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL  
THE HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL  
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING IN ALEXANDER PLACE,  
AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND DRIVING  
IN FAIRFIELD LANE) (INVERNESS) ORDER 1976

1. NOTICE is hereby given that the Highland Regional Council propose to make an Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 the effect of which will be:—

- (a) that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in any of the lengths of the road specified in Schedule 1 hereto and 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in any of the lengths of the road specified in Schedule 2 hereto. Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, the maintenance of the roads, building operations, the supply of gas, electricity and water, disabled drivers, the fire brigade, the police, ambulance and local authorities in the pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
- (b) that no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the length of the road specified in Schedule 3 detailed below. Exceptions will permit driving for the purposes of access to premises, building operations, maintenance of the road, the supply of gas, electricity and water, disabled drivers, the fire brigade, police, ambulances and local authorities in the pursuance of statutory powers and duties.

2. Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a Map showing the lengths of roads in question and a Statement of the Regional Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Department of Law and Administration, Regional Buildings, Glenurquhart Road, Inverness during normal office hours Mondays to Fridays except public holidays.

3. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of the grounds for the objection in writing to the undersigned by 1st September 1976.

SCHEDULE 1

*Alexander Place, Inverness (East Side)*

From a point on the kerbline 10 metres south of the south kerbline of Young Street southwards to the north kerbline of Ardross Terrace.

*Alexander Place, Inverness (West Side)*

From a point on the kerbline 23 metres south of the south kerbline of Tomnahurich Street southwards for a distance of 68 metres.

From the southern edge of carriageway of Ardross Place southwards to the north kerbline of Ardross Street.

SCHEDULE 2

*Fairfield Lane, Inverness (East Side)*

From a point on the kerbline 10 metres north of the north kerbline of Tomnahurich Street northwards for a distance of 68 metres.

*Fairfield Lane, Inverness (West Side)*

From a point on the kerbline 10 metres north of the north kerbline of Tomnahurich Street northwards and westwards to the east kerbline of Kenneth Street.

SCHEDULE 3

*Fairfield Lane, Inverness*

The whole length of Fairfield Lane (that is, from its junction with Tomnahurich Street to its junction with Kenneth Street).
