#### NATIONAL INSURANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF DRAFT REGULATIONS ENTITLED THE SOCIAL SECURITY (BENEFIT) (PERSONS ABROAD) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1977

THE National Insurance Advisory Committee give notice that they have received, in accordance with Section 139 of the Social Security Act 1975, for consideration and report thereon, the preliminary draft of regulations entitled The Social Security (Benefit) (Persons Abroad) Amendment Regulations 1977.

A short explanatory note on these regulations is appended to this notice. The Committee will take into consideration any objections made by or on behalf of persons affected, received by them not later than 8th July 1977. Objections should be addressed to the Secretary, National Insurance Advisory Committee, Keysign House, 429 Oxford Street, London W1R 2HT. Copies of the preliminary draft of these regulations can be obtained by sending a stamped addressed foolscap envelope to the Secretary to the Committee.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

The regulations amend certain provisions of the Social Security (Persons Abroad) Regulations 1975, which set out the circumstances in which the disqualification for the receipt of benefit during the periods of absence from Great Britain may be removed. In the case of certain benefits, provision is made for the removal of the disqualification where the Secretary of State has certified that it is consistent with the proper administration of the Social Security Act 1975 that the disqualification should not apply and where certain conditions set out in the 1975 regulations are satisfied.

The regulations also amend certain of the provisions of the Social Security (Attendance Allowance) (No. 2) Regulations 1975 and the Mobility Allowance Regulations 1975 which set out the conditions relating to residence or presence in Great Britain on which entitlement to attendance allowance and mobility allowance depends. Provision is made that one of the conditions shall be that the Secretary of State has certified that it is consistent with the proper administration of the Social Security Act 1975 that where another condition set out in the 1975 regulations is satisfied the person concerned should be treated as if he/she were present in Great Britain.

#### WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

*Notice of Intention to make a Variation Order to Exclude from the Scope of the Licensed Non-Residential Establishment Wages Council Licensed House Managers and their Spouses and certain other categories of workers.*

THE Secretary of State for Employment in accordance with Schedule 1 to the Wages Councils Act 1959, as amended by the Employment Protection Act 1975, hereby gives notice that he intends, pursuant to his powers under Section 4(2) of the 1959 Act, to make a Variation Order to exclude the following categories of worker from the scope of the Licensed Non-residential Establishment Wages Council:—

- 1) Licensed house managers, including relief and trainee managers, and their spouses; and
- (2) Workers who are employed as club secretaries, doormen, entertainers, greenkeepers, gardeners, groundsmen or skittle-alley attendants in licensed non-residential establishments (for whom minimum remuneration has not been set by the Council).

Objections to the draft Order must be sent to the Secretary of State at the above address not later than 22nd July 1977. Every objection must be in writing and must state:

- (a) the specific grounds of objection, and
- (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked for.
