- (D) In regard to Paragraphs (B) and (C) above, exceptions will permit driving or waiting, as the case may be, for the purpose of:

- (i) enabling a person to board or alight from a vehicle.
- (ii) enabling goods to be loaded or unloaded from a vehicle, where necessary in connection with:
- (iii) the maintenance of roads, and
- (iv) the supply of gas, electricity and water, and by
- (v) disabled drivers

Copies of the Orders together with a map showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected in the Roads Department, Woodhill House, Ashgrove Road West, Aberdeen, at the Area Roads Office, Maud, and at Arbutnott House, Broad Street, Peterhead, from Monday to Friday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 12 noon and 2 p.m. and 5 p.m.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Section 133 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1973 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks from the 28th day of July 1977, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
