CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956
GLASGOW EAST END (No.1)
SMOKE CONTROL AREA ORDER 1977

NOTICE is hereby given that the City of Glasgow District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 of the above mentioned Act on the Twenty-fourth day of November, 1977, made an order entitled "The Glasgow East End (No.1) Smoke Control Area Order 1977" declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a SMOKE CONTROL AREA, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for Scotland for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of Section 11(4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels are: anthracite and semi-anthracite, briquetted fuels carbonised in the process of manufacture, coke, electricity, gas, low temperature carbonisation fuels and low volatile steam coals.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Office of the Director of Administration City Chambers, 78 Cochrane Street, Glasgow G2 1DU and at the Office of the Scottish Development Department, Pentland House, Robb's Loan, Edinburgh EH14 1TY at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the twentieth day of February, 1978. Within the said period, any person who will be affected by the Order may, by writing to the Secretary of State for Scotland, Pentland House, Robb's Loan, Edinburgh, EH14 1TY, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area referred to in Paragraph 1 of the Notice is the area in the City of Glasgow District comprising 557 acres (255 hectares) or thereby which is bounded by a line commencing at a point at the centre of the Tollcross Burn at the centre of Tollcross Road; thence north and eastward along the centre of Tollcross Burn to the former City of Glasgow municipal boundary; thence north and westward along the former City of Glasgow municipal boundary to the centre of the former London and North Eastern Railway; thence westward along the centre of the former London and North Eastern Railway to the junction of the centre line of the former London, Midland and Scottish Railway; thence south and westward along the centre line of the former London, Midland and Scottish Railway to the centre of Duke Street; thence south and eastward along the centre of Duke Street to the centre of Tollcross Road; thence south and eastwards along the centre of Tollcross Road to the point of commencement, which area is delineated red and coloured pink on the map referred to in paragraph 3 of this notice.
