LOOM WALK, KILBARCHAN
PROPOSED PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES
EXCEPT FOR ACCESS

STRATHCLYDE REGIONAL COUNCIL propose to introduce an Order to prohibit driving a motor vehicle in Loom Walk, Kilbarchan.
