EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations amend the Social Security (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) Regulations 1975 [SI 1975 No. 564] so as to provide that a person following a course of full-time education at a university, school or comparable establishment must satisfy an additional condition in order to establish entitlement to unemployment benefit for a day falling within the academic year of that establishment.
