HARBOURS ACT 1964

THE CROMARTY FIRTH PORT AUTHORITY  
REVISION ORDER 1978

NOTICE is hereby given that the Cromarty Firth Port Authority have applied to the Secretary of State for Transport to make a Harbour Revision Order under Section 14 of the Harbours Act 1964.

The objects of the proposed Order are:—

- (a) to extend the period within which the Authority have power under Section 29 of the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973 to acquire certain lands for purposes of reclamation, from 31st December 1980 to 31st December 1988;
- (b) to extend until 31st December 1988 the period beyond which development authorised by that Order will not be deemed to be "permitted development" under Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning (General Development) (Scotland) Order 1975;
- (c) to re-define, so as to coincide with the landward boundary of the foreshore, the level of the banks of Cromarty Firth comprising the landward limits of the port.

A copy of the draft Order which accompanied the application may be seen at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Cromarty Firth Port Authority, Port Office, Invergordon and at the offices of the undersigned Solicitors and Parliamentary Agents.
