NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Acts, on the 31st day of January 1979 made a Compulsory Purchase Order entitled The Gretna-Stranzaer-Glasgow-Stirling Trunk Road (Drumflower Bridge Diversion) Compulsory Purchase Order 1979.
