DISEASES OF FISH ACT 1937

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State has made the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Revocation Order 1979. This Order revokes two earlier Orders, the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Order 1974 and the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) No. 3 Order 1975 and declares part of Kames Bay, Loch Melfort, Argyll and the premises of the Kames Fish Farm, Kilmelford, Argyll, no longer infected areas in terms of Section 2(1) of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937. The restrictions on movement of live fish, eggs of fish and foodstuffs for fish out of this area has been lifted.

This Order will come into force on 28th February 1979.
