(MONCKS ROAD, FALKIRK)

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1979

THE Central Regional Council propose to make an Order under Section 1(1), (2), (3) and (3C) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and by Section 133 of and Schedule 14 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 and by Section 24(2) of and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, which, in effect, will impose waiting restrictions in Moncks Road, Falkirk, as described in the Schedules hereto.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:—

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading or unloading goods where necessary in connection with:
- (c) the maintenance of roads; and
- (d) supply of gas, electricity and water; and by
- (e) disabled drivers, doctors, nurses.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the proposed restrictions and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during normal office hours at (i) the Regional Council Offices, Viewforth, Stirling (Room 13) and (ii) at the District Council Offices, Falkirk District Council, Municipal Buildings, Falkirk (within the Administration Department's Enquiry Office on the first floor) for three weeks from 1st June 1979.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of the grounds for objection in writing to the undersigned by 22nd June 1979.

SCHEDULE I

Road in Falkirk	Side and section of road on which waiting is prohibited at any time
Callendar Road	On the north side thereof from the line of the east kerbline of Moncks Road for a distance of 15 metres or thereby in an easterly direction. On the north side thereof from the line of the west kerbline of Moncks Road for a distance of 15 metres or thereby in a westerly direction.
Moncks Road	On both sides thereof from the north kerbline of Callendar Road for a distance of 15 metres or thereby in a northerly direction. On both sides thereof from the south kerbline of Cromwell Road for a distance of 15 metres or thereby in a southerly direction.
Cromwell Road	On the south side thereof from the line of the east kerbline of Moncks Road for a distance of 15 metres or thereby in an easterly direction. On the south side thereof from the line of the west kerbline of Moncks Road for a distance of 15 metres or thereby in a westerly direction.

SCHEDULE II

Road in Falkirk	Side and section of road on which waiting is prohibited between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive
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
