NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR
PIPELINE RE-ROUTE CONSTRUCTION
AUTHORISATION

SHELL U.K. LIMITED hereby gives notice in accordance with the provisions of Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Pipe-Lines Act 1962, that an application has been made to the Secretary of State for Energy for the grant of an authorisation for the construction of a re-routed sections of the proposed St. Fergus Cruden Bay cross-country pipeline between Newseat, St. Fergus and Ardlaw, Longside and between Bridgend, Cruden and Nether Broadmuir, Cruden. The pipeline, as previously advertised on 13th March 1979, is to be for the conveyance of hydrocarbon condensates (butane and heavier fractions) from the St. Fergus gas separation plant to the BP installation at Cruden Bay, Banff and Buchan, and has been re-routed to accommodate various objections.

The pipeline will be owned by Shell U.K. Limited and Esso Petroleum Company Limited.
