THE Secretary of State for Scotland by this ticence issued under the terms of Article 3(2) of the Importation of Animals Order 1977 hereby authorises, subject to and in accordance with the conditions set out below, the landing in Great Britain of Cattle originating from the Republic of Ireland at Glasgow, Cairneyan and Strangaer.

- All landings of cattle shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Importation of Animals Order 1977 and with the following provisions of this licence.
- 2. The cattle, having landed at a port specified above shall immedia:ely be taken under the terms of the Importation of Animals Order 1977, to an approved Reception Centre linked with that port, as specified below:-

- 3. Cattle for breeding or production
  - (a) Each consignment of cattle shall be accompanied by the following certificates signed by a veterinary officer appointed by the Government of the Republic of Ireland:-
    - (i) a certificate in accordance with Annex F, Model 1 of BEC Directive 64/432 (as amended).
    - (ii) a certificate as set out in the Annex hereto.
  - (b) Categories of cattle permitted to be landed:-
    - (i) cattle derived from officially brucellosis free herds;
    - (ii) caule derived from brucellosis free herds provided they have passed the serum agglutination test for brucellosis within 30 days of loading are onvac-cinated against brucellosis and in the case of female cattle are not pregnant and not showing permanent incisor teeth; or
    - (iii) casuated males coming from herds of no brucellosis status provided they are under 30 months of age (see note 1).

#### 4. Cattle for slaughter

- (a) Each consignment of cattle shall be accompanied by a certificate in accordance with Annex F, Model 2 of EEC Directive 64/432 (as amended) and signed by a veterinary officer eppointed by the Government of the Republic of Ireland.
- (b) If the cattle derive from herds of no brucellosis status they must have passed the serum agglutination test at less than 30 its within 30 days of loading (see note 1).
- (c) If the cattle derive from herds of no tuberculosis status they must have passed the comparative tuberculin test criteria currently notified to the Department of Agriculture, Dublin, by the Ministry of Agriculture, F; sheries and Food, London.
- (d) Cartle in categories (b) and (c) must be shipped direct to Great Britain.

#### NOTES:

- Castrated males are exempt from testing from brucellosis unless they are intended to join officially brucellosis free herds in Great Britain in which case special transport arrangements should be made.
- 2. Officially brucellosis free and brucellosis free animals must be kept separate from each other and from animals which are neither officially brucellosis free nor brucellosis free during transportation and in the Reception Centre. Failure to observe this requirement will result in all the animals being classified in the lower/lowest category.
- 3. Any person wishing to land animals in Great Britain under the terms of this licence must make arrangements in advance, with the occupier of the reception centre to which the animals are intended to be taken after landing, for accommodation of the animals.
- 4. The carrier of imported animals must, in accordance with larticle 4(7) of the Importation of Animals Order 1977, notify the person in charge of the approved reception centre to which those animals are licensed to be moved of the proposed time of landing of those animals, and of their number and description.
