NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Acts, on the 17th day of December 1979 made a Compulsory Purchase Order entitled The Aberdeen-Huntly-Fochabers Trunk Road (West Adamston) Compulsory Purchase Order 1979.

The Order provides for the purchase of land described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of carrying out a road improvement on a section of the Aberdeen-Huntly-Fochabers Trunk Road (A96) at West Adamston in Grampian Region.

A copy of the Order as made and of the map referred to therein have been deposited at the offices of the Scottish Development Department, New St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh and Grampian Regional Council, Woodhill House, Ashgrove Road West, Aberdeen and may be seen there without payment of fee during business hours.

The Order as made becomes operative on the 28th day of December 1979 being the date on which this notice is first published; but a person aggrieved by the Order may in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 15 of Schedule 1 to the Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure) (Scotland) Act 1947 as extended by Section 60 of the Land Compensation (Scotland) Act 1973 by application to the Court of Session within 6 weeks from that date, question its validity on the grounds (i) that the authorisation granted by the Order is not empowered to be granted or (ii) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by failure to comply with any statutory requirement relating to the Order.

The Secretary of State may acquire the land and the rights in land to which this Notice related by making a General Vesting Declaration under Section 278 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972. Such a Declaration shall not be executed before the end of the period of two months beginning with the date of the first publication of this notice except with
