(YETT FARM AND WHITTAGREEN FARM, NEWARTHILL)

SMOKE CONTROL AREA ORDER 1980

1. NOTICE is hereby given that the Motherwell District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 of the above mentioned Act on the 22nd day of May 1980, made an Order entitled the Motherwell District (Yett Farm and Whittagreen Farm, Newarthill) Smoke Control Area Order 1980, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for Scotland for confirmation.
2. The Order will not come into operation until at least 6 months after it is confirmed by the Secretary of State.
3. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of Section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels are: Anthracite and semi-anthracite; low volatile steam coal; low temperature carbonisation fuels; manufactured solid smokeless fuels; briquetted fuels carbonised in the process of manufacture; Phurnacite Ovoids; Gluco and Gas Coke; Homefire and Room-heat; Multiheat; Sunbrite and 'Hard' Coke; Cosiglow; Maxiglow; Fireglo Briquettes; Ancit Briquettes; Extracite Ovoids; Syntacite Ovoids; XL Briquettes; Anthracine Ovoids; Anthrite Ovoids; Palmalite Ovoid Briquettes; fluidised char binderless briquettes manufactured by the National Coal Board; Rexco Briquettes; Durafyre Ovoids; electricity and gas.
4. Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Civic Centre, Motherwell during office hours for a period of 6 weeks commencing the 14th day of June 1980. Within that period any person who will be affected by the Order may object to its confirmation by writing to The Secretary, Scottish Development Department, New St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh EH1 3SX.

ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL

(KIRKWALL) (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1980

1. THE Orkney Islands Council have made an Order under Section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.
2. When this Order comes into effect on 1st July 1980 vehicles will be charged for parking as detailed in the Schedule hereto in the car parks at Albert Street/Bridge Street, Junction Road/Castle Street and Gunn's Close, (Kirkwall and restrictions will be imposed on the type of vehicle which may park within the car parks. The maximum stay permitted during the period 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday will be 4 hours.
3. Exceptions will permit unlimited waiting within the car park by disabled drivers.
4. Full details of these proposals are in the Order which, together with a map showing the respective car parks, may be examined at Council Offices, Kirkwall from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Monday to Friday of each week.

ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

THE ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL

(VICTORIA STREET, KIRKWALL) (EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1980

1. ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL have made an Order under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.
2. When this Order comes into effect on 1st July 1980 no person shall for a period of 6 months drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in Clause 4 hereof.
3. Exceptions will permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified if the vehicle is being used:—
 - (a) in connection with the Fire, Police, Medical or Ambulance Services;
 - (b) in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the collection of refuse or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, electricity or any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
