Glasgow to Fort William
Trunk Road A.82

From the centre line of the west-most of two bridges over the Allt Fionn Ghlinne Burn along the centre line of the old road (Old Military Road) in a south westerly direction for a distance of 310 m or thereby, to its junction with the new road.

Also from the centre line of the bridge described above along the centre line of the old road (Old Military Road) in an easterly direction for a distance of 373 m or thereby to its junction with the new road.
A total distance of 683 m.
