THE GRAMPIAN REGIONAL COUNCIL

(BISHOP'S BRIDGE, CRUDEN BAY)  
(WEIGHT RESTRICTION)  
ORDER 1980

1. THE Grampian Regional Council has made the above Order under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.
2. The effect of the Order is to make it unlawful to drive a vehicle, the weight of which if unladen exceeds 30 hundredweights, on Bishop's Bridge, Cruden Bay. Exemption is made when the vehicle is being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the Bridge, the removal of any obstruction to traffic on the Bridge, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Bridge, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair, in or adjacent to the Bridge, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
3. The Order will come into effect on 15th September 1980.
