CERTIFICATES OF TAX DEPOSIT (SERIES 5)

ON and after Monday, 3rd November 1980 the rates of interest applicable to deposits accepted under the Prospectus (Series 5) dated 31st July 1980 and applied in payment of a scheduled liability will be 15%. The rate of interest on deposits withdrawn for cash will be 11½%. An interest supplement, which is only payable in respect of a deposit applied in payment of a scheduled liability, of 2% will be paid in respect of the first 3 months of a deposit. A nil rate of bonus will apply to deposits held for more than 6 months and applied in payment of a scheduled liability. These rates remain in force until further notice.

On and after the 3rd November 1980 these rates also apply until further notice to deposits made under the earlier Pros-

pectuses (Series 1, 2, 3 and 4) which reach the second or fourth anniversary of the deposit, as applicable, in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein.

THE BUILDING SOCIETIES (AUTHORISED BANKS) (No. 98) ORDER 1980

THE Chief Registrar of Friendly Societies, with the consent of the Treasury, pursuant to the powers conferred on him by Section 59(2) of the Building Societies Act 1962 and to all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. Bank of New South Wales is hereby designated as authorised to hold funds of Building Societies as mentioned in Section 59(1) of the Building Societies Act 1962.
2. This Order may be cited as the Building Societies (Authorised Banks) (No. 98) Order 1980.
