The following diseases have never been recorded in Great Britain: African horse sickness (pestis equorum), African swine fever (pestis suum africana), blue tongue (febris cararrhalis ovium), dourine (exanthema coitale paralyticum), equine encephalomyelitis (meningo-encephalomyelitis enzotica eq.), lumpy skin disease (dermatosis nodularis) and Teschen disease (encephalomyelitis enzotica suum).
