(ROUTE A8) (PROHIBITION OF SPECIFIED TURNS)

(CARNBROE)

ORDER 1981

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order which will (a) prohibit any vehicle proceeding on the westbound carriageway of the Edinburgh-Glasgow (A8) trunk road, from making a right-hand turn into Carnbroe Road (b) prohibit any vehicle proceeding southwards in Carnbroe Road from making a right-hand turn onto the westbound carriageway of the Edinburgh-Glasgow (A8) trunk road and (c) prohibit any vehicle proceeding on either carriageway of that length of the Edinburgh-Glasgow (A8) trunk road as measured from the east side of the bridge carrying the Holytown-Chapelhall road (B799) over the said trunk road westwards for a distance of 8071 metres to a point coinciding with the east side of Bredisholm footbridge, so as to make a U-turn across the line of the central reservation in order to proceed in the opposite direction to that in which it was proceeding.
