(TEMPORARY 30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 1982**

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order temporarily imposing a 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit on that length of the Gretna-Stranraer-Glasgow-Stirling Trunk Road (Route A80) in Strathclyde Region from the east kerbline of the turn-off to the Mollinsburn-Condorrat link road westwards to a point 125 metres west of the centre line of Badenheath Bridge, a distance of 750 metres.

This further Order is required to allow for the completion of the roadworks which were held up due the adverse weather conditions.
