(FORT AUGUSTUS—30M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT)

ORDER 1982

NOTICE is hereby given that the Highland Regional Council intend to make an Order in terms of Section 74 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended entitled as above.

(CRAMOND GLEBE ROAD, EDINBURGH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)

ORDER 1982

THE Lothian Regional Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, have made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting, at weekends from May to September each year, on the section of Cramond Glebe Road, Edinburgh, described in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 1st May 1982 together with (1) a map showing the road affected and (2) a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be examined at The Lothian Regional Council's Headquarters, George IV Bridge, Edinburgh, between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 3.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays both inclusive.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of said Act of 1967 or any regulation made under it, has not been complied with in relation to said Order may, within 6 weeks from 14th April 1982 apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

Length of Road in Edinburgh where waiting will be prohibited between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays from 1st May to 30th September each year

That length of Cramond Glebe Road extending from a point approximately 20 metres south of the entrance to the car park to the northern extremity of Cramond Glebe Road including the turning areas in Riverside/Granton-Cramond Promenade.
