SUBMARINE PIPE-LINE WORKS AUTHORISATION

PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY UNITED KINGDOM LIMITED hereby gives notice on behalf of itself and Phillips Petroleum Company, Fina Exploration Limited, Century Power and Light Limited, Ultramar Exploration Limited, The British Electric Traction Company Limited, and the British National Oil Corporation, in accordance with the provisions of Part I of Schedule 4 to the Petroleum and Submarine Pipe-lines Act 1975, that it has made an application to the Secretary of State for Energy for the grant of an authorisation for the construction and use of a submarine pipe-line for the conveyance of Crude Oil between the Maureen Platform 16/29A and an articulated loading column.
