- (ii) At all other on-street public parking places in the "Central Area" as described in Part I of Schedule 5 to the 1973 Order the charges will be 10p for 20 minutes, 20p for 40 minutes, 30p for 1 hour, 40p for 1 hour 20 minutes, 50p for 1 hour 40 minutes and 60p for 2 hours (maximum period).
- (iii) At all on-street public parking places in the "Peripheral Area" as described in Part II of Schedule 5 to the 1973 Order the charges will be 10p for 1 hour, 20p for 2 hours, 30p for 3 hours and 40p for 4 hours (maximum period).
- (iv) The excess charge for leaving a vehicle in any public parking place for longer than the initial period for which payment has been made will be £5.
