RETAIL TRADES (NON-FOOD) WAGES COUNCIL (GREAT BRITAIN)

THE Retail Trades (Non-Food) Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of proposals for amending the provisions relating to customary holidays as set out in the Wages (Retail Non-Food Trades) Order 1982 (Order NF(8)).
