 (ROUTE M9) (POLMONT TO FALKIRK)
 (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he has made the above Order temporarily prohibiting the driving of vehicles whilst temporary roadworks, indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, are in progress on that length of the London-Edinburgh-Thurso Trunk Road (Route M9) between Polmont and Falkirk in Central Region as measured from a point 75 metres northwest of the centreline of the bridge carrying the B904 road (Polmont to Grangemouth/Bo'ness) over the M9 northwestwards for a distance of 6.8 kilometres to the centreline of the bridge carrying the A88 road (South Bellsdyke Road) over the M9.

The closure which is required to allow reconstruction work to be carried out will take place from 7th February 1983 to 6th August 1983.

Alternative Routes for Traffic:

While the northwestbound carriageway, or part thereof, is closed two-way traffic will be in operation on the southeastbound carriageway and vice-versa.

PARAGUAY: OFFICIAL CERTIFICATE

THE Secretary of State for Scotland in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food (Scotland) Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 1181), as amended by the Imported Food (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1973, 1979 and 1981 (S.I. 1973 No. 1471, S.I.

1979 No. 1537 and S.I. 1981 No. 1035) gives notice that he hereby recognises, subject to the conditions hereinafter set out, the Official Certificate of which particulars are given in the First Schedule hereto as showing:—

- (a) that the meat from which any meat product was prepared was derived from mammals inspected before and after death in the country of origin of the meat and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Secretary; and
- (b) that the preparation and packing of the meat or meat product was carried out with all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.

The said Certificate is recognised subject to the following conditions:—

1. Recognition applies to the importation of meat or meat products (excluding those derived in whole or in part from poultry meat) from Paraguay only, but does not apply to any meat or meat product derived from animals killed when wild.
2. Where the Official Certificate is in the form of a stamp or label, recognition will apply only if the stamp or label is securely marked or affixed to the meat or to packages of meat products as well as to any container in which the meat or meat products are packed and if the stamp or label has not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as an Official Certificate.
3. Recognition is restricted to the extent shown in the Second Schedule hereto.
