**THE TRUNK ROADS (ROUTE M9) (PLEAN)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND
CARRIAGEWAYS) ORDER 1984**

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order temporarily closing:

- (1) That length of the eastbound carriageway of the Edinburgh-Stirling Motorway (Route M9) in Central Region from a point 620 metres southeast of the south overbridge at the Bannockburn Interchange southeastwards for a distance of 1.95 kilometres.
- (2) That length of the westbound carriageway of the Edinburgh-Stirling Motorway (Route M9) in Central Region from a point 620 metres southeast of the south overbridge at the Bannockburn Interchange southeastwards for a distance of 1.95 kilometres.

The Order which is required to allow the installation of traffic measuring equipment will operate from 7th May 1984 until 4th June 1984.

**THE TRUNK ROADS (ROUTE M8)
(STRATHCLYDE REGION) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF
TRAFFIC) ORDER 1984**

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order temporarily restricting traffic on lengths of the trunk road (Route M8) in Strathclyde Region. To enable roadworks to be carried out from a point where the said trunk road meets the boundary between Strathclyde Region and Lothian Region, 1.6 kilometres east of the Harthill Service Area, westwards for a distance of 13.2 kilometres to the junction of the said road M8 and A8 trunk road at Newhouse Interchange, it will be necessary from time to time to restrict traffic by carriageway or lane closures over a period up to 13th May 1985.

While such closures are in operation traffic will be confined to a single lane width with or without opposing traffic on the adjacent lane.

**THE TRUNK ROADS (ROUTE M90) (MASTERTON)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NORTHBOUND AND
SOUTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAYS) ORDER 1984**

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the above Order temporarily closing:

- (1) That length of the northbound carriageway of the Inverkeithing-Perth Motorway (Route M90) in Fife Region from a point 426 metres south of the southern overbridge at Junction 3 (Halbeath) to a point 32 metres of the overbridge carrying the Masterton-Inverkeithing Road (C67) a distance of 4 kilometres.
- (2) That length of the southbound carriageway of the Inverkeithing-Perth Motorway (Route M90) in Fife Region from a point 426 metres south of the southern overbridge at Junction 3 (Halbeath) to a point 32 metres of the overbridge carrying the Masterton-Inverkeithing Road (C67) a distance of 4 kilometres.
- (3) That length of the northbound slip road connecting the Pitreavie Spur Motorway A823(M) with the Inverkeithing-Perth Motorway (M90) from a point 80 metres northwest of the Masterton overbridge northeastwards for a distance of 300 metres.

The Order which is required to allow essential maintenance work to be carried out will operate from 8th May 1984 until 15th June 1984.
