TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

1. THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Securities Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street, on Friday, 8th March 1985, at 1 p.m., for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877, and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £100,000,000.
2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000, £100,000, £250,000 or £1,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business day from Monday, 11th March 1985 to Friday, 15th March 1985 inclusive and will be due 91 days after date.
3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.
4. Each Tender must be for an amount of not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent (being a multiple of one halfpenny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates.
5. Tenders must be made through a London Banker, Discount House or Broker.
6. Notification will be sent on the same day as Tenders are received to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part. Payment in full of the amounts due in respect of such accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England by means of cash or by draft or cheque drawn on the Bank of England not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated.
7. Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Bank of England.
8. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right of rejecting any Tenders.

TREASURY MINUTE dated 6th March 1985

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read Section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with Section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quota at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 6th March 1985 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- I. The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- II. Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments,

whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 1985**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Acts has made a Compulsory Purchase Order entitled The Perth-Aberdeen-Inverness Trunk Road (Forfar Bypass) Compulsory Purchase Order 1985.

The Order provides for the purchase of the lands described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of constructing a new length of the Perth-Aberdeen-Inverness Trunk Road.

A copy of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 8th March 1985 to 19th April 1985, at the offices of the Scottish Development Department, New St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh EH1 3SZ; the offices of Tayside Regional Council, Tayside House, Dundee; Dundee and Angus Area Roads Headquarters, Kirriemuir Road, Forfar; and Angus District Council, County Buildings, Forfar, Angus.

The Order as made becomes operative on 8th March 1985, but if application is made to the Court of Session under Paragraph 15 of the

First Schedule to the Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure) (Scotland) Act 1947, as extended by Section 60 of the Land Compensation (Scotland) Act 1973, within a period of six weeks from that date by any person aggrieved by the Order who desires to question the validity thereof the Court of Session may, by interim Order, suspend the operation of the Order or any provision contained therein, either generally or insofar as it affects any property of the applicant and may, if satisfied that the authorisation granted by the Order is not empowered to be granted or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirement of the said Schedule or of any regulation made thereunder not having been complied with, quash the Order or any provisions contained therein either generally or insofar as it affects any property of the applicant.

The Secretary of State may acquire the land and the rights in the land to which this Notice relates by a General Vesting Declaration under Section 278 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972. The effect of the making of such a declaration is to vest the land and rights in the land in the Secretary of State at the end of the appropriate period and is more fully explained in Form 9 of The Compulsory Purchase of Land (Scotland) Regulations 1976 (SI 1976 No. 820). A copy of the said Regulations has also been deposited and may be seen as aforesaid.
