THE Social Security Advisory Committee gives notice that it has been asked by the Secretary of State for Social Services under Section 10 of the Social Security Act 1980 to consider and report on the draft of regulations entitled the Housing Benefit Amendment Regulations 1986.

A short explanatory note provided by the Department of Health and Social Security on these regulations is appended to this Notice. The Committee will take into account any comments or objections made by or on behalf of people or organisations who would be affected by the Regulations, received by them not later than 24th January 1986. EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Department of Health and Social Security propose to make amendments to the Housing Benefits Regulations to exclude from eligibility people provided with accommodation under Part III of the National Assistance Act 1948, Section 59 of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 and Section 21 of the National Health Services Act 1977. Where such residents claim housing benefit, the effect is generally to reduce the cost to the local authority of providing the accommodation rather than benefit the claimants themselves. The responsibility for providing such accommodation lies with social services departments, and the Government considers that the cost should not be subsidised through the housing benefits scheme.

RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS BY THE PUBLIC WORKS LOAN COMMISSIONERS TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES

TREASURY MINUTE dated 11th December 1985

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read Section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with Section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quota at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 11th December 1985 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- I. The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- II. Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
