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#### THE HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL (CAMERON SQUARE, FORT WILLIAM) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER 1985

#### THE HIGHLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL (CAMERON LANE, FORT WILLIAM) (ONE - WAY) ORDER 1985

NOTICE is hereby given that The Highland Regional Council have made the above-named Orders in terms of Sections 1, 2, 3 & 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The first-mentioned Order prohibits the driving of vehicles in Cameron Square, Fort William, except for pedal cycles and vehicles requiring access to Cameron Square and Viewforth Car Park. The second-mentioned Order makes traffic flow in Cameron Lane one-way from Cameron Square to Viewforth Lane and Viewforth Car Park. Both Orders come into effect on 6th January 1986.

Copies of the Orders and plans showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected at the Divisional Planning Office, Tweeddale, High Street, Fort William, and the Highland Regional Council, Department of Law and Administration, Regional Buildings, Glenurquhart Road, Inverness, on weekdays, during business hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of either Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within
