The mark to be applied to animals imported by land into Northern Ireland from the Republic of Ireland shall be a circular punch hole about 16 millimetres in diameter and a tattoo mark comprising an arrow, two numerals and either a numeral or a letter, and it shall be applied to the right ear. The mark to be applied to all other animals hereby required to be marked shall be a circular punch hole about 16 millimetres in diameter and it shall be applied to the left ear.

So long as a requirement under this Notice is in force in any part of the United Kingdom in respect of animals of any class, it is an offence for any person, with intent to evade the requirement, to bring an animal of that class into that part of the United Kingdom, at a place or time other than one at which facilities are available for marking the animal in accordance with the requirement. Where an animal of that class has been brought into that part of the United Kingdom it is an offence for the person in charge of the animal not to present it forthwith for marking, or for any unauthorised person to move it after it has been presented and before it has been marked.
