 ORDER 1978

MARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR BOVINE ANIMALS
 BROUGHT INTO THE UNITED KINGDOM

THE Intervention Board for Agricultural Produce hereby give notice, pursuant to Article 13 of the above mentioned Order that they require the marking in accordance with this Notice of all bovine animals brought into the United Kingdom from any place outside the United Kingdom on or after 12th May 1986, with the following exceptions:

- A. Registered pedigree animals intended for breeding.
- B. Animals listed in any permit issued by or on behalf of the Board to any person occupying land in the Republic of Ireland and adjacent land in Northern Ireland, when those animals are being moved from one of those areas to the other in accordance with the terms of the permit.
- C. Animals brought into Great Britain from other member states of the European Economic Community.
- D. Animals from the Isle of Man certified by the relevant authorities as being in-calf.

Marking requirements under this Notice shall be operative until further notice and the marking shall be done by or under the supervision of an Officer authorised by or on behalf of the Board for that purpose. Marking facilities will be available at the following places and times:
