**THE ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL
(VICTORIA STREET, KIRKWALL)**

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (No. 1) ORDER 1985

1. ON 29th April 1986, the Orkney Islands Council made the above-named Order under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to 3 and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. This Order, which comes into operation on 1st June 1986, makes it unlawful to leave a vehicle between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
3. Exceptions will permit waiting:
 - (a) for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or to be unloaded from a vehicle;
 - (c) where necessary in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of roads, and the supply of gas, water, electricity or telegraphic services;
 - (d) where necessary in connection with statutory powers and duties; and
 - (e) by disabled drivers.
4. A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road affected are available at the Department of Administration and Legal Services, Council Offices, Kirkwall, between 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.
5. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from 29th April 1986, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

- (i) On the west side of Victoria Street, Kirkwall, from a point 15.4 metres from its junction with Union Street, Kirkwall, to a point at the boundary between the Royal Bank of Scotland, Victoria Street, Kirkwall, and 7 Victoria Street, Kirkwall.
- (ii) On the east side of Victoria Street, Kirkwall from a point 15.4 metres from its junction with Union Street, Kirkwall, to a point opposite the northernmost gable of 10 Victoria Street, Kirkwall.
