A PROCLAMATION

FOR DISSOLVING THE PRESENT PARLIAMENT, AND
DECLARING THE CALLING OF ANOTHER

ELIZABETH R.

Whereas We have thought fit, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, to dissolve this present Parliament: We do, for that End, publish this Our Royal Proclamation, and do hereby dissolve the said Parliament accordingly: And the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Members of the House of Commons, are discharged from further Attendance thereat: And We being desirous and resolved, as soon as may be, to meet Our People, and to have their Advice in Parliament, do hereby make known to all Our loving Subjects Our Royal Will and Pleasure to call a new Parliament: And do hereby further declare, that, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, We have given Order that Our Chancellor of Great Britain and Our Secretary of State for Northern Ireland do respectively, upon Notice thereof, forthwith issue out Writs, in due Form and according to Law, for calling a new Parliament: And We do hereby also, by this Our Royal Proclamation under Our Great Seal of Our Realm, require Writs forthwith to be issued accordingly by Our said Chancellor and Secretary of State respectively, for causing the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons who are to serve in the said Parliament to be duly returned to, and give their Attendance in, Our said Parliament on Wednesday, the seventeenth day of June next, which Writs are to be returnable in due course of Law.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this eighteenth day of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven and in the thirty-sixth year of Our Reign.

EUROPEAN PHARMACOPOEIA

THE Ministers, that is to say the Secretary of State concerned with health in England, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Wales and Scotland, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, hereby declare under Section 65(7) and (8) of the Medicines Act 1968 that on and after 1st July 1987 the Monographs contained in the Ninth and Tenth Fascicules of the Second Edition of the European Pharmacopoeia, published under the direction of the Council of Europe (Partial Agreement) in accordance with the Convention on the Elaboration of a European Pharmacopoeia are to have effect for the purposes of Section 65 of the said Act.

TREASURY MINUTE dated 20th May 1987

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read Section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with Section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quotas at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 20th May 1987 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- I. The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- II. Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.) or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

From 1st June 1987 the Schedule to both Licence A and Licence B shall be varied to delete all entries in respect of frequency band 50.00 MHz to 50.50 MHz and frequency band 70.025 MHz to 70.500 MHz in the first column of the Schedule and to replace them respectively with entries in respect of frequency band 50.00 to 52.00 and frequency band 70.00 MHz and 70.50 MHz in the first column. This means that both Class A licensees and Class B licensees may transmit within these frequency bands in accordance with the amended Schedule entries shown below.
