#### GRAMPIAN REGIONAL COUNCIL

#### ENZIE - CUNNINGHAUGH ROAD AND DALLACHY ROAD

GRAMPIAN Regional Council proposes to make the Grampian Regional Council (Enzie – Cunninghaugh Road and Dallachy Road) (Weight Restriction) Order 1987, under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order will be to restrict the movement of goods vehicles, with a gross laden weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes, on that length of the U8E Enzie – Cunninghaugh Road from 350 metres north of the junction with the U10E Dallachy Road to 800 metres south of that same junction, and on that length of the U10E Dallachy Road for its entire length from the B9104 Fochabers – Spey Bay Road to the U8E Enzie – Cunninghaugh Road.

Exemptions will permit passage:-

- where necessary in connection with any building operation or demolition; the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance of roads; and supply of gas, water, electricity and telecommunication services;
- (2) to enable the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during normal office hours in the Roads Department, Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen and at the offices of the Divisional Surveyor, Moray Divisional Office, Academy Street, Elgin.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of the grounds for objection in writing to the undersigned by 15th December 1987.
