GRAMPIAN REGIONAL COUNCIL

CASTLE STREET AREA, ABERDEEN

GRAMPIAN Regional Council proposes to make the Grampian Regional Council (Castle Street Area, Aberdeen) (Experimental) (Traffic Management) Order 1988, under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2), 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, which will operate for an experimental period of twelve months initially, will be to prohibit any person from driving any vehicle on that area of Castle Street bounded on its east side by a parallel line 5 metres west of Castle Street's east kerb line extended northwards, and on its west side by a line between the east kerb lines of King Street and Marischal Street.

Exemptions to the prohibition of driving are specified for vehicles being used:
