HEALTH MARK : AUSTRIA

THE Secretary of State for Scotland in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food (Scotland) Regulations 1985 (SI 1985, No 913), gives notice that he hereby recognises, subject to the conditions hereinafter set out, the health marks described in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto for the importation from Austria of fresh meat and meat products as showing:—

- (a) that the fresh meat to which they relate, or the meat from which the meat product to which they relate was prepared, was derived from mammals inspected before and immediately after death and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Secretary of State; and
- (b) that the dressing, packing and other preparation of the fresh meat or meat product was carried out with all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.

The said health marks are recognised subject to the following conditions:—

- (i) recognition applies only to fresh meat and meat products imported from Austria but does not apply to any such meat and meat products derived from mammals killed when wild.
- (ii) where the health marks are in the form of stamps or labels, recognition will apply only if the stamps or labels have not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as a health mark.

Recognition of the health marks is restricted to the extent shown in Part 2 of the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the Edinburgh Gazette, dated 3rd June 1986, is hereby revoked.
