(PEDESTRIANISATION, WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING RESTRICTIONS AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 1988

NOTICE is hereby given that Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council propose to make the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

1. The general effect of the Order will be to pedestrianise and control the waiting, loading/unloading of vehicles in specified lengths of roads in Dumfries Town Centre; certain one-way traffic operation is also included.
2. Exceptions to the proposed restrictions are as stated in the Order.
3. The proposed restrictions incorporate amendments which take account of objections and representations made following first publication of the Order in October 1987. Previous objectors should take particular note of these amendments.
4. Details of the proposals, with a plan showing the restricted lengths of roads, and a statement of reasons for the proposed Order, may be inspected at the Council Offices, English Street, Dumfries.
5. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of their objections, in writing, to the undersigned by 14th April 1988.
