**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSENT IN
PURSUANCE OF SECTION 34**

NOTICE is hereby given, in accordance with Section 36(1)(a) of the Control of Pollution Act 1974, that an application has been made to the Solway River Purification Board by Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council, Council Offices, Dumfries, for consent to discharge nine cubic metres per day of sewage effluent into the Boreland Burn at NGR NY 171 911 from Boreland Septic Tank, Boreland, Lockerbie.

Any person who wishes to make representations about the application should do so in writing to the Solway River Purification Board, Rivers House, Irongray Road, Dumfries DG2 0JE, not later than 16th August 1988, quoting Reference 42/88.

DISEASES OF FISH ACT 1937 (AS AMENDED)

NOTICE is hereby given that the Secretary of State has made the Diseases of Fish (Designated Area) (Scotland) (No. 11) Order 1988. This Order declares the area comprising the salmon rearing cages occupied by Western Isles Salmon Limited and Stornoway Trust situated in Loch Leurbost at the site known as Meavaig Island to be a designated area for the purposes of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937 (as amended), and provides for the control of the movement of live fish, live eggs of fish and food stuff for fish out of the area. The Order will come into force on 2nd July 1988.
