THAT THE SAID NICKEL-BRASS COINS SHALL HAVE
CURRENCY AND THE AMOUNT FOR WHICH THEY
SHALL BE LEGAL TENDER

WHEREAS under section 3(a), (b), (cc), (d), (dd), (f), and (ff) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the denomination, design, dimensions, weight and composition of coins to be made at Our Mint, to determine the remedy to be allowed in the making of such coins and the percentage of impurities which they may contain, and to direct that such coins, other than those of gold, silver, cupro-nickel and bronze, shall be current and that all such coins be legal tender for payment of any amount:

And Whereas under section 6(2) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, by Proclamation, to prescribe the composition of the standard trial plates to be used for determining the justness of coins issued from Our Mint of any metal or mixture of metals other than gold, silver and cupro-nickel:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable to order that, in commemoration of the tercentenary of the Bill of Rights and the tercentenary of the Scottish Claim of Right in the year One thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, there should be made at Our Mint in silver and in nickel-brass coins of the denomination of two pounds:

We, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 3(a), (b), (cc), (d), (dd), (f), and (ff) and of the said section 6(2) and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:—

SILVER COINS

1. (1) A new coin of silver of the denomination of two pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 31.952 grammes, a standard diameter of 28.4 millimetres and a standard composition of thirty-seven-fortieths fine silver and three-fortieths alloy or millesimal fineness 925, and being circular in shape.
- (2) In the making of the said silver coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter or composition specified in subsection (1) above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:—
 - (a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin (measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogramme of the coin) of 0.145 grammes;
 - (b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.1 millimetres per coin; and
 - (c) a variation from the said millesimal fineness of five per mille.
- (3) A new coin of silver of the denomination of two pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 15.976 grammes, a standard diameter of 28.4 millimetres and a standard composition of thirty-seven-fortieths fine silver and three-fortieths alloy or millesimal fineness 925, and being circular in shape.
- (4) In the making of the said silver coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter or composition specified in subsection (3) above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:—
 - (a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin (measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogramme of the coin) of 0.095 grammes;
 - (b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.1 millimetres per coin; and
 - (c) a variation from the said millesimal fineness of five per mille.

NICKEL-BRASS COIN

2. (1) A new coin of nickel-brass of the denomination of two pounds shall be made, being a coin of a standard weight of 15.976 grammes, a standard diameter of 28.4 millimetres and a standard composition of seventy per centum copper, five and one-half per centum nickel and twenty-four and one-half per centum zinc, and being circular in shape.
- (2) In the making of the said nickel-brass coin a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight, diameter of composition specified in subsection (1) above) shall be allowed of an amount not exceeding the following, that is to say:—
 - (a) a variation from the said standard weight of an amount per coin (measured as the average of a sample of not more than one kilogramme of the coin) of 0.095 grammes;
 - (b) a variation from the said standard diameter of 0.1 millimetres per coin; and
 - (c) a variation from the said standard composition of two per centum copper, three-quarters per centum nickel and two per centum zinc.
- (3) The said coin may contain impurities of 0.75 of one per centum.
- (4) The said coin shall be current and be legal tender for payment of any amount in any part of Our United Kingdom.
- (5) The composition of the standard trial plates to be used for determining the justness of the said nickel-brass coin shall be pure copper, pure nickel and pure zinc.

DESIGNS FOR THE SILVER AND NICKEL-BRASS COINS

3. The designs for the said silver and nickel-brass coins shall be as follows:—

For the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH. II. DEI. GRATIA. REGINA. F.D." and the words "TWO POUNDS", and for the reverse either

- (a) a Cypher of the letters W and M interlaced and surmounting a Parliamentary Mace horizontally placed and having a representation of the Royal Crown above and the dates 1689 and 1989 below, all within the inscription "TERCENTENARY OF THE BILL OF RIGHTS",

or

- (b) a Cypher of the letters W and M interlaced and surmounting a Parliamentary Mace horizontally placed and having a representation of the Crown of Scotland above and the dates 1689 and 1989 below, all within the inscription "TERCENTENARY OF THE CLAIM OF RIGHT".

The coins shall have a graining upon the edge.

4. This proclamation shall come into force on the twenty-second day of December One thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight.

Whereas under section 3(1)(b) and (h) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the design of any coin to be made at Our Mint and to alter any Proclamation previously made under the said section:

And Whereas by Our Proclamation dated the 4th day of October 1953 We determined a new design for the gold coins specified in Our said Proclamation, being the five-pound piece, the two-pound piece, the sovereign and the half-sovereign:

And Whereas by Our Proclamation dated the 17th day of April 1985 We altered the paragraph headed "GOLD COINS" of Our said Proclamation of the 4th day of October 1953 to determine a new design for the said gold coins:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable to determine a new design for the said gold coins:

We, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 3(1)(b) and (h) and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:—

1. The following paragraph shall be substituted for the paragraph headed "GOLD COINS" of Our said Proclamation of the 4th day of October 1953:—

"GOLD COINS

- (1) Five-Pound Piece — Every five-pound piece shall have either

(a) for the obverse impression Our effigy with the inscription "ELIZABETH II DEI.GRA.REG.F.D" and for the reverse image of Saint George armed, sitting on horseback, attacking the dragon with a sword, and a broken spear upon the ground, and the date of the year, or

(b) for the obverse impression a representation or Ourselves as at Our Coronation, seated in King Edward's Chair and having received the Sceptre with the Cross and the Rod with the Dove, all within the circumscription "ELIZABETH.II. DEI.GRA.REG.FID.DEF", and for the reverse a Shield of Our Royal Arms ensigned by an open Royal Crown, the whole superimposed upon a double Rose, and with the circumscription "ANNIVERSARY OF THE GOLD. SOVEREIGN. 1489-1990".

The coins shall have a graining upon the edge.

- (2) Two-Pound Piece — Every two-pound piece shall have the same obverse and reverse impression and inscription in all respects as the five-pound piece described in either paragraph (1)(a) or (1)(b) above. The coins shall have a graining upon the edge.
- (3) Sovereign — Every sovereign shall have the same obverse and reverse impression and inscription in all respects as the five-pound piece described in either paragraph (1)(a) or (1)(b) above. The coins shall have a graining upon the edge.
- (4) Half-sovereign — Every half-sovereign shall have the same obverse and reverse impression and inscription in all respects as the five-pound piece described in either paragraph (1)(a) or (1)(b) above. The coins shall have a graining upon the edge.

2. This Proclamation shall come into force on the twenty-second day of December One thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight.
