## MEDICINES ACT 1968

### EUROPEAN PHARMACOPOEIA

THE Ministers, that is to say the Secretary of State for Health, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Wales and Scotland, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, hereby declare under and for the purposes of section 65(8) of the Medicines Act 1968 that the monograph for Dried Human Fibrinogen (No. 24) contained in fascicule 11 of the second edition of the European Pharmacopoeia, published in accordance with the Convention on the Elaboration of a European Pharmacopoeia, will cease to form part of the European Pharmacopoeia on 1 April 1989 and the revised version of the monograph for Water for Injections (No. 169/1988), adopted by the European Pharmacopoeia Commission on 24 November 1988 in replacement for the monograph No. 169/1984 contained in fascicule 8, is to have effect on 1 April 1989.

## THE PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) (LANDWARD AREAS) REGULATIONS 1984 (SI 1984 NO 1832)

1. The Secretary of State for Energy, with the consent of the Treasury, has determined that until further notice, the consideration for Petroleum Development Licences for landward areas (previously provided for in paragraph 10 (c) of a notice in the issue of this Gazette dated 2 July 1985) shall be calculated in accordance with the following provisions.
2. All Development Licences shall be held subject to an annual rental payable upon acceptance of the offer of a licence and at twelve-monthly intervals thereafter.
3. The rental on Development Licences shall be the product of the number of square kilometres held under licence and a figure in £ sterling called the rental rate, which may be varied periodically in accordance with the provisions below. The actual rental payable from time to time for a Development Licence shall be calculated by reference to the rental rate in force on the date the rental becomes payable.
4. The rental rate represents the rental payable per square kilometre of licensed acreage.
5. The Secretary of State may set a new rental rate upon completion of an oil price review. If a new rental rate is so set, it will come into force on 1 October of the year in which the oil price review has been carried out.
6. All rental rates except the first will be set for an initial period of three years and will remain in force thereafter until superseded by a new rental rate or until further notice. The first rental rate will be £1500 per square kilometre of licensed acreage.

7. Oil price reviews will be carried out at three yearly intervals from the first review, which will be carried out early in 1990.
8. At the first review the Secretary of State shall determine the arithmetical average level over the three calendar years 1984, 1985 and 1986 of the monthly Crude Oil Price Index published in the Digest of UK Energy Statistics (the first figure), and the arithmetical average of the Crude Oil Price Index for the three calendar years 1987, 1988 and 1989 (the second figure), and shall express the increase or decrease between the first and second figure as a percentage of the first figure. The outcome of this calculation shall be called the percentage change.
9. At the second and all subsequent oil price reviews the Secretary of State shall perform an equivalent calculation based on the arithmetical average of the oil price index over the three calendar years immediately preceding the last oil price review and the arithmetical average of the oil price index in the last three calendar years immediately preceding the year of the review.
10. Except where he sets a deemed rental rate under paragraph 12, the Secretary of State shall set a new rental rate by applying the percentage change derived from the calculation referred to in either paragraph 8 or 9 above to the existing rental rate, and thereby producing a new rental rate.
11. Where the existing rental rate is a deemed rental rate the Secretary of State shall perform the calculation referred to in paragraph 8 or 9 above but substituting for the first figure the notional level of the Crude Oil Price Index which would have produced the existing deemed rental rate. He shall then apply the percentage change so derived to the existing deemed rental rate to produce a new rental rate.
12. The Secretary of State shall set a deemed rental rate when:
- the rental rate derived from the oil price review would be less than £1500 in which case the deemed rental rate will be £1500;
  - the rental rate derived from the oil price review represents less than a 10% change (either upwards or downwards) in the level of the existing rental rate (whether deemed or not), in which case the new deemed rental rate will be the same as the existing rental rate.

**RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS BY THE  
PUBLIC WORKS LOAN COMMISSIONERS TO  
LOCAL AUTHORITIES**

**NOTICE**

TREASURY MINUTE dated 28th February 1989.

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read Section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with Section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quotas at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer, now recommends that with effect from 1st March 1989 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest

paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.) or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);

The amount which a local authority borrows within its annual quota will bear interest at the appropriate rate in the quota set of rates. Authorities may borrow further sums at quota rates at the discretion of the Public Works Loan Commissioners. Other borrowing beyond the quota entitlement will be at the appropriate rate in the non-quota set of rates.

## THE OLD BEARSDEN CONSERVATION AREA

NOTICE is hereby given that Bearsden and Milngavie District Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 262 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") have designated the area known as Old Bearsden as a Conservation Area entitled the "Old Bearsden Conservation Area".

The extent of the Conservation Area and the properties located therein are set out in the Schedule hereto. A plan showing the extent of the Conservation Area may be inspected free of charge, at the Chief Planning Officer's office at 2 Grange Avenue, Milngavie.

The designation of the above mentioned Conservation Area will take effect from 3rd March 1989.

Where any area is for the time being designated as a Conservation Area, special attention shall be paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing its character or appearance in the exercise, with respect to any building or other land in that area, of any powers under Part 1 of the Historic Buildings and Ancient Monuments Act 1953, the Local Authorities (Historic Buildings) Act 1962 or the Act.

In terms of Section 262A of the Act, subject to the provisions of that Section, any building in a Conservation Area (other than those excepted by the said Section 262(A)) shall not be demolished without the consent of the District Council or the Secretary of State. In addition, Sections 53, 54(3), (4), (5) and (6), 54A, 54B, 54C, 92 to 95, 161, 179, 253(1)(b), Parts I and II of Schedule 10 and Schedule 17, of the Act shall have effect in relation to buildings to which the said Section 262A applies as they have effect in relation to listed buildings.

In terms of Section 59A of the Act, subject to the provisions of that Section, any person who, in relation to a tree in a Conservation Area which is not the subject of a Tree Preservation Order, does any act which might by virtue of Section 58(1)(a) of the Act be prohibited by a Tree Preservation Order shall be guilty of an offence. Sub-section 8 of the said Section 59A also provides that if any tree to which the said Section 59A applies, is removed, uprooted or destroyed in contravention of that Section, or is removed, uprooted or destroyed or dies at a time when its uprooting or felling is authorised only by virtue of the provisions of any Regulations made by the Secretary of State, it shall be the duty of the owner of the land, unless on his application the District Council dispense with this requirement, to plant another tree of an appropriate size and species at the same place as soon as he reasonably can.

In terms of Section 25 of the Act, subject to the provisions of that Section, any application for planning permission for the development of land which would, in the opinion of the planning authority, affect the character of appearance of a Conservation Area, requires to be advertised.

In terms of Section 61(3) of the Act, subject to the provision of that Section, the Secretary of State is empowered, in making regulations for the control of advertisements, to make special provision concerning the control of advertisements in Conservation Areas.

In terms of Section 97 of the Act, subject to the provisions of that Section, if the Secretary of State is satisfied, in the case of an unlisted unoccupied building in a Conservation Area, that it is important to preserve the building for the purpose of maintaining the character or appearance of the Conservation Area, he may direct that Section 97 of the Act is to apply to that building. Any works urgently necessary for the preservation of the building may then be carried out by the planning authority or the Secretary of State.
