> THE ZOONOSES ORDER 1988 (SI 1988 NO. 2264)

Section 29 of the Animal Health Act 1981 ("the Act") empowers Ministers with a view to reducing the risk of human health from any disease of animals, to make an Order designating any such disease which, in their opinion, constitutes such a risk and applying any provision of the Act to that disease.

The Order designates bovine spongiform encephalopathy for the purposes of section 29 (article 3(1)) and applies certain provisions of the Act to bovine spongiform encephalopathy with a view to reducing any risk to human health from that disease (article 3(2) and the Schedule).

The Order also amends article 2 of the Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy Order 1988 so that the definition of "disease" as extended by that article will now apply for all the purposes of the Act without being restricted to the purposes of that Order (article 4).

Schedule 1 which lists approved disinfectants includes newly approved disinfectants, and Schedule 2 lists disinfectants which are now omitted from Schedule 1 but which may nevertheless continue to be used as approved disinfectants until 30th June 1989 (article 2(c)).

AUTHORISATION UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE GAS ACT 1986 OF PERSONS SUPPLYING GAS THROUGH PIPES TO PREMISES FROM SMALL CONTAINERS OF LIQUEFIED GAS

- THE Director General of Gas Supply, in accordance with the general authority given to him by the Secretary of State pursuant to section 8(1) of the Gas Act 1986 (c.44), hereby authorises any person, not otherwise authorised by or under Part 1 of the Act and to whom the circumstances specified in paragraph 2 below apply, to supply gas through pipes to any premises subject to section 8(5) of the Act.
- The circumstances referred to in paragraph 1 above which are to apply to a person hereby authorised are that the supply of gas through pipes to the premises is to be provided by means of:—
 - (a) a single vessel containing not more than 47 kilograms of gas, consisting wholly or mainly of propane or butane in a liquid state; and
 - (b) a pipe having a length of not more than 2 metres between the vessels referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above and the point where the pipe enters the building or other structure in which the gas is to be used.
- 3. This authorisation shall come into operation on 21st February 1989 and shall continue in force for a period of three years unless previously revoked by the Director General of Gas Supply after the expiration of a period of three months beginning with the publication or first publication of his intention to do so in the London Gazette and the Edinburgh Gazette.

RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS BY THE PUBLIC WORKS LOAN COMMISSIONERS TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES

TREASURY MINUTE dated 7th March 1989

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read Section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with Section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quotas at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 8th March 1989 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- I. The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- II. Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.) or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
