THE PERTH-DUNDEE TRUNK ROAD (A972)
(KINGSWAY, DUNDEE) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 1989

THE Secretary of State gives notice that he proposes to make the above order imposing a 50 mph speed limit on that length of the Perth-Dundee Trunk Road Route (A972) at Kingsway, Dundee from a point on the southwest side of the roundabout situated at the junction of the A972 and Myrekirk Road in a generally easterly direction to the west side of the roundabout situated at the junction of the A972 and Forfar Road, a total distance of 6.4 kilometres or thereby.
