Supplement No 8 to British Approved Names 1986

THE Ministers, that is to say the Secretary of State for Health, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Wales and in Scotland, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, having on the recommendation of the Medicines Commission caused to be published an eighth supplement to *British Approved Names 1986* hereby give notice under section 102(5) of the Medicines Act 1968 that the subject matter contained in the said supplement shall take effect on 31st December 1989.

For the purposes of section 102(6) of the Medicines Act 1968, the Department of Health has been authorised by the said Ministers to print copies of the subject matter contained in the said supplement.

EUROPEAN PHARMACOPOEIA

THE Ministers, that is to say the Secretary of State for Health, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Wales and Scotland, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, hereby declare under section 65(7) and (8) of the Medicines Act 1968 that on and after 1st January 1990 the monographs contained in the twelfth fascicule of the second edition of the European Pharmacopoeia, published under the direction of the Council of Europe (Partial Agreement) in accordance with the Convention on the Elaboration of a European Pharmacopoeia, are to have effect for the purposes of section 65 of the said Act.

Copies of the said second edition of the European Pharmacopoeia have been printed and published by Maisonneuve S.A. of 57160 Sainte-Ruffine, France.

WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1949

CLEARANCE OF UHF FREQUENCY BAND OF FIXED
LINKS AND SCANNING TELEMETRY LINKS

NOTICE OF VARIATION AND REVOCATION

THE Secretary of State gives notice pursuant to section 1(4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949 to all licensees holding

FIXED RADIO-RELAY LINK LICENCES

(including any letter of authority to operate a fixed radio-relay link) that, with effect from 1st January 1990 —

- (a) such licences which authorise the establishment or installation, and use, of any fixed link in the 450-470 MHz frequency band in addition to any fixed link outside that frequency band, are hereby varied with the effect that the establishment or installation, and use, of any fixed link in the 450-470 MHz frequency band shall no longer be authorised, with the exception of links from an onshore site to a floating vessel at sea; and
- (b) such licences which authorise only the establishment or installation, and use, of any fixed link in the 450-470 MHz frequency band, other than any fixed link from an onshore site to a floating vessel at sea, are hereby revoked.

The Secretary of State gives notice pursuant to section 1(4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949 to all licensees holding

SCANNING TELEMETRY LINK LICENCES

(including any letter of authority to operate a scanning telemetry link) that, with effect from 1st January 1990 —

- (a) such licences which authorise the establishment or installation, and use, of any scanning telemetry link in the 450-470 MHz frequency band are hereby varied with the effect that only those scanning telemetry links operating on frequencies within the sub-band 457.5/458.5 MHz to 463/464 MHz are authorised, and the establishment, installation and use of any scanning telemetry link that does not satisfy the above condition shall no longer be authorised; and
- (b) such licences which authorise only the establishment or installation or use of scanning telemetry links which do not satisfy the above condition are hereby revoked.
