ANIMAL HEALTH ACT 1981

THE IMPORTATION OF SALMONID VISCERA ORDER 1986 (SI 1986 NO 2265)

GENERAL LICENCE TO IMPORT VISCERA WHETHER OR NOT DETACHED FROM DEAD FISH : VARIATION

1. In pursuance of Section 10 of the Animal Health Act 1981 and Article 3 of the Importation of Salmonid Viscera Order 1986, the

Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland, and the Secretary of State for Wales hereby vary the General Licence granted on 21st January 1987 so as to remove Norway from the list of territories in sub-paragraphs 1(a) and 1(b) from which imports of salmonid viscera are authorised.

2. This variation to the aforementioned General Licence takes effect from 25th December 1989.

a. This variation has the effect of limiting the authorisation for imports of salmonid viscera to Northern Island, Republic of Ireland, and the Isle of Man.

b. The importation of eviscerated fish of the family *Salmonidae* is permitted and is not affected by the General Licence as varied.

c. The Diseases of Fish Act 1937 (as amended) prohibits the importation into Great Britain of live fish of the family *Salmonidae*.

d. NOTICE

TREASURY MINUTE dated 19th December 1989

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read Section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with Section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quotas at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 20th December 1989 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- I. The rate of interest applicable to any such fixed rate loan will be that in force on the day the authority applies to borrow or, if the application is before noon three working days before the loan is credited to the account of the authority's banker, the rate in force at 11 a.m. two banking days before credit day;
- II. Different rates of interest shall be charged on such fixed rate loans according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.) or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
