CONDITIONS ATTACHING TO THIS LICENCE

Each consignment must be accompanied by a certificate signed by a duly authorised Veterinary Officer of the Government of Canada certifying:-

1. a. Details of the consignment; (nature of consignment, eg inedible poultry offal, number of packages, identification marks, etc)
- b. The registered number and address of slaughtering and dressing plant.
2. That the whole of the consignment so described was derived from poultry which:-
 - a. were subject at the slaughterhouse named to ante-mortem inspection by an authorised veterinary officer and to post-mortem inspection under the supervision of an authorised veterinary officer and no sign of disease was detected;
 - b. originated from flocks in which, within the preceding 2 months, none of the following diseases had been diagnosed:-
Fowl Plague, Newcastle Disease, Salmonellosis, Fowl Cholera (Pasteurellosis), Ornithosis, Duck Plague, Duck Virus Hepatitis, Duck Virus Enteritis, Goose Influenza and Arizona Infection;
 - c. have not been in contact at the slaughterhouse with any poultry affected by any of the diseases mentioned in b. above;
 - d. were hatched, reared and slaughtered in a Province in which after due enquiry the authorised veterinary officer was satisfied that no outbreak of a velogenic strain of Newcastle Disease has occurred in the 6 months prior to slaughter;
 - e. were hatched and reared on holdings on which there has been no case of avian influenza diagnosed during the 3 months prior to slaughter and within 3 kms of which there has been no case of avian influenza diagnosed within 3 months prior to slaughter;
 - f. were slaughtered and processed at premises within 3 kms of which there has been no case of avian influenza diagnosed within the 3 months prior to slaughter.
3. The poultry offal shall be packed in leakproof containers or packages and on arrival shall be transported direct from the point of landing to a licensed processor where it shall be sterilised. The name and address of the licensed processor shall be stated on the above certificate.
