This Order further amends the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1978 by adding to the list of approved disinfectants in that Order those newly approved disinfectants which are mentioned in Schedule 1 to this Order (article 3(1)) and by deleting from that list the disinfectant mentioned in Schedule 2 (article 3(2)). The disinfectant deleted may, however, continue to be used as approved disinfectant until 31st December 1990 (article 3(3) and (4)).

FORESTRY COMMISSION

THE Forestry Commissioners hereby give notice that they have made an Order under the Plant Health Act 1967 entitled The Import and Export (Plant Health Fees) (Forestry) (Great Britain) Order 1990.

The Order prescribes fees in respect of the services listed in Schedules 1, 2, and 3 to the Order (articles 3 to 7). These services are performed in connection with applications received for the issue of phytosanitary certificates or licences in accordance with the provisions of the Plant Health (Forestry) (Great Britain) Order 1989. Certificates are required to accompany exports of certain wood, wood products, seeds, forest tree plants, soil and used forestry machinery. Licences are issued to enable the importation of articles which would otherwise be prohibited.

Schedule 1 prescribes fees for Great Britain in respect of export certification services for wood, wood products and seeds in respect of import licensing services for wood and wood products. Schedule 2 (relating to England and Wales) and Schedule 3 (relating to Scotland) prescribe fees in respect of export certification services for the inspection of forest tree plants, soil and used forestry machinery and in respect of import licensing services for forest tree plants. The different structure and scales of fees set out in Schedule 2 for services provided in England and Wales and in Schedule 3 for Scotland reflect the arrangements made for similar agricultural and horticultural services in those countries in the Import and Export (Plant Health Fees) (England and Wales) Order 1988, and the Import and Export (Plant Health Fees) (Scotland) Order 1989.

As regards the export certification services, the Order prescribes basic fees in column 3 of Part 1 of Schedules 1 and 2 (article 3) and in certain circumstances provides for the payment of lower alternative fees which are shown in colmn 4 of Part 1 of Schedules 1 and 2 (articles 4 and 5).
